

* NMBOPHB Wellness Fund Grant Application *

The New Mexico Board of Pensions and Health Benefits provides a grant opportunity for clergy, clergy spouses and their dependent children to proactively improve their spiritual, mental and physical health. Any retired clergy or clergy under full-time appointment may apply to the BOPHB for this grant.

Items that may be considered (not limited to) are spiritual direction, coaching, help with weight loss, physical fitness training, gym memberships, and exercise equipment.

Requests will be reviewed by the BOPHB sub-committee and all requests will remain confidential. If approved, the sub-committee will decide what percentage of the request will be funded.

Disbursements may be made on a one time or repeating basis, depending on the nature of the request. Approved gym memberships will be paid on a quarterly basis once receipts are received.

Only a limited number of grants are available each year. The submission of a completed application does not guarantee awarding of a grant. Three BOPHB members, elected by the BOPHB, shall constitute the Wellness Fund Review Committee. All grant requests will be strictly confidential. Only one Wellness Grant per clergy household will be funded per calendar year.
