- All groups must have Safe Sanctuary (or equivalent) training prior to arrival
- There are 2 separate bunkrooms & bathrooms for men & women.
- Teams should provide their own bedding & personal hygiene items.
- Teams are responsible for their own meals.
- Available visit weeks – March through October.
